#### **Our Learning**

This half term our project will be "Down My Street". This will include:

Science and DT: Everyday materials and how we can use these

History: Own life changes (family homes and events) and looking at how our school has changed

RE: How was Jesus special? Harvest

Geography : Our locality

Art: Primary and secondary colours, colour mixing

Computing: Getting to know the iPads and e-safety

PE: Outdoor and adventurous activities

Mrs Kennerley's class will also have Dance.

English: Traditional tales and familiar settings

Maths: Number facts, comparing numbers, ordering numbers

#### Homework

The children will receive a piece of homework and a set of spellings each Friday. These must be completed and returned to school by the following Wednesday.

We will also send home phonic bookmarks each week that will match the sounds we have looked at in class. Please continue to practise these at home.

The children will receive a Maths Passport. Please follow the instructions at home to support your child.

Children will also bring home a reading book. This may be changed as often as required. Children should read at least three times a week at home. Please record in their reading record each time your child reads.

#### Phonics

You may be aware that every child in Year 1 will take the Phonics Screening test in June next year. Please do not book a holiday for the weeks beginning 11th and 18th June. The children will be required to blend a variety of real and pseudo words. We have already begun working on this during our phonics lessons. Further information and practice materials will be sent home over the course of the year.

Please ensure all children come to school with a water bottle.

Children should have their book bags in school every day with their reading record. We will soon be giving each child a green spelling book which needs to stay in their book bag.
