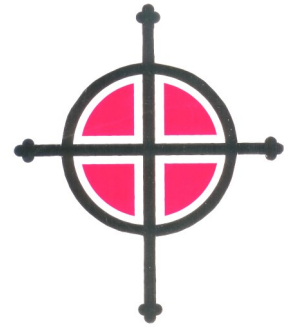

E-Safety

Make these conversations part of your family routine:

- Ask your child where their favourite places are online & who they talk to.
- Ask your child if they have ever seen any content that upsets them or promotes extreme views, of any kind. Open up discussion and find out what they think.
- Talk to your child about how you want them to behave online. Make sure they understand that the way they behave online should be the same as the way you want them to behave offline.
- Discuss family technology rules for your house and keep talking about them.
- Make sure you have set up the technology in your house the way you want to. Explore settings and parental controls & update them as your children grow.
- Set some boundaries. Remember tired children don't make good decisions.
