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Reception Newsletter – 13th July 2018

Language

Last week in our writing we wrote shape poems about different sports. We thought about what we knew about the sport and then wrote a poem that included 'star words'. The children had to use their writing checklists to self-assess their work to make sure they had remembered all of their writing targets. The children were very creative when writing their poems and used lots of exciting vocabulary! This week have read a book called 'Football Skills'. The children then enjoyed making mind maps about what they already know about football. The children then wrote instructions about how to play football. They have also looked at the different football kits from the World Cup teams and have written sentences to describe them.

<u>Maths</u>

Our maths work last week involved solving problems involving measures. The children thought about what tools they would use to measure different lengths and height. The children then used cubes and hands to measure and order a range of different lengths. We also helped the England football team to pack their cases for their next World Cup game. We weighed a objects using cubes and made sure that we did not take anything that was heavier than 20 cubes. Later in the week we focused on solving time problems. This week we have been practising counting on and back to solve number problems and also exploring 2d and 3d shapes.

Our final set of spellings for this half term is listed below. We will be assessing the children on their ability to spell these words in the next couple of weeks and we will then send home their scores. We are also continuing to assess spellings from tests that have taken place throughout the year. Our current spellings are:
