Y4 Lego Workshop

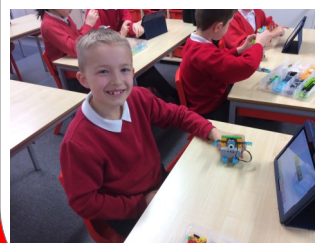
