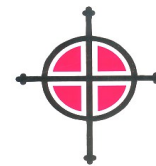

Welcome Back

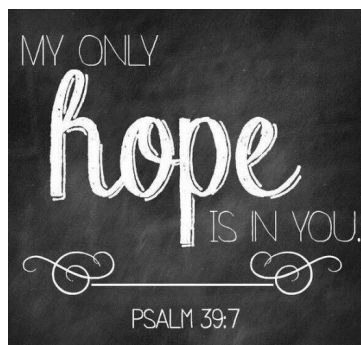
It is lovely to welcome all the children back to school after the holidays. We wish them every blessing in their new classes. A special welcome goes to our new Reception class children who have all settled in very well.

APPLYING FOR A YEAR 7 PLACE FOR SEPTEMBER 2019

To apply for a year 7 place for September 2019, you will need to register your family's details using the Citizen Portal and then complete an online application form.

Please find enclosed a secondary information leaflet which contains important information regarding the registration and online application processes. **You are advised to read it carefully before applying.**

The on-line facility will be available from **Monday 3 September 2018 until midnight on Wednesday 31 October 2018.**

SWIMMING

Applying for a Reception Place for September 2019.

Parents of children born on or between 1st September 2014 and 31st August 2015 need to apply for a place in Reception Class for September 2019. The online application is available from 3rd September 2018 until the closing date of 15th January 2019.

The online system is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week up to midnight on 15th January 2019.
