## SAFETY QUEST

On Tuesday of last week, Y5 had the wonderful opportunity to attend a unique new facility in Lymm. Safety Central has been purpose built, alongside the new fire station, as a teaching facility for children in KS1, 2 and 3. Safety Quest is an education package, which means that children can see what danger in their everyday lives might look like and teaches them what to do to prevent these dangers, but also what to do in an emergency. We learnt about everything, from checking your smoke alarm to what to do if you find an unconscious person following an accident. All of the children - and the accompanying adults - agreed that they had learnt so much and that they would be better equipped to spot and avoid dangers in the future.

Children in Need was a huge success today, we raised a total of £453.46. Thank you to everyone that took part.

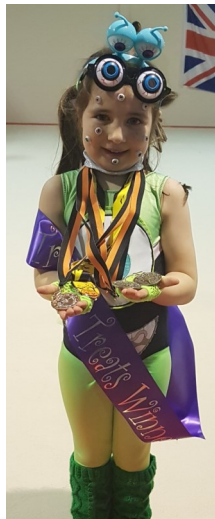


Please be aware that the service road at the back of school by church should not be used to drop off or pick up children. Any cars doing this will be reported to the police.
