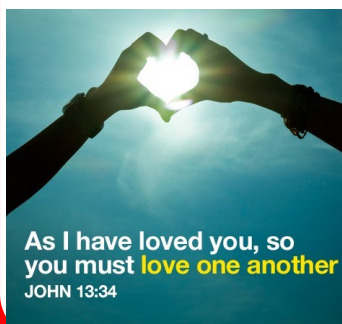
## Egyptian Day

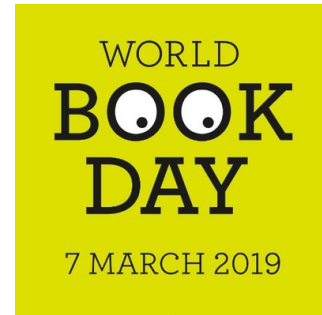

### Polite Reminder

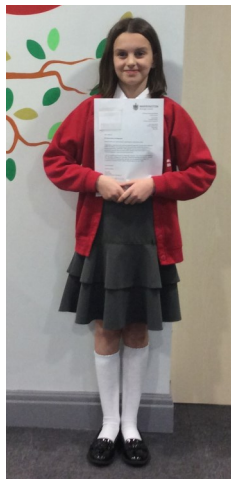
Any payments sent into school should be in a sealed envelope with your child's name and reason for payment clearly marked on it.
