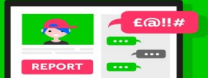
Student Recognition

We will be running a Holiday Club at Half Term for children who attend St Philip's as follows:

Please note that the club will only run if we have enough children on each day and the places will be allocated on a first come first served basis.

Parent Pay

Please note that from Monday 1 April we will no longer be making calls or sending text messages to remind parent/carers to top-up their Parent Pay accounts. This is taking up too much time for our office staff who are employed by the school. School meals are provided by the Local Authority's School Meal Service.

In order to ensure that your child receives their school meal it is essential that your Parent Pay account has sufficient money on it before lunch service starts at 12.30pm.

Please be reminded that we cannot guarantee your child will receive a school meal if sufficient funds are not on your account to pay for it.

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
