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Reception's Home Learning Task 26.05.17

Dear Parents,

After the holidays our new project will be entitled 'Who's afraid of the Big Bad Wolf?'

We will be exploring a number of traditional tales, including Jack and the Beanstalk. We will also be sharing non-fiction books about plants and seeds. Children will be learning about how seeds grow and, ultimately, where our food comes from. In preparation for this work we are setting the children a home learning task.

Today, all of the children have planted a seed in a pot. We have discussed the things we need to do to look after our seeds and help them to grow. The children are now responsible for looking after their seed and watching to see how it changes over the holidays.

This task carries with it a range of learning opportunities that will support the children in all areas of the Foundation Stage Curriculum. Please see some examples of these on the back of this letter. If the children choose to complete any of these additional activities please let us know in their homework book!

Following the holidays, we would like the children to bring their plant pots back to school so that we can compare our plants and share our experiences of how we helped them to grow. The children will then plant them in our outside classroom.
