Playground

A lot of our work this year has focused upon developing our outdoor fun. Following the installation of the new Ball Pitch, we agreed rules with all the children in our classes and had a professional sign made which is on display. The children also requested new equipment for use during our happy Lunchtimes activities and lots of things have been purchased including new skipping ropes, class skipping ropes, balls, hoops, cones, rounders bats, cricket bats, a class parachute and lots more! Behaviour Policy

We surveyed the children to find out their thoughts on our use of dojos for rewards. The children suggested the use of Bronze, Silver and Gold Awards to recognize their achievements in being awarded dojos. This has now been agreed with the Senior Leadership Team and from September this will now take place: 100 dojos for Bronze, 200 dojos for Silver and 300 dojos for Gold.
