The only PE for the next 5 weeks is swimming on Thursdays.

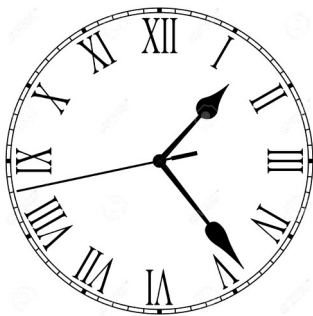
Children should have their book bags and reading records in school every day.
