Reading	Share a book with an adult 3 times a week. You should be reading for approximately 15 minutes each time, and once you've completed the session, an adult needs to sign your planner. There should be 3 reading signatures a week. We will check the planners on Wednesday.
Spelling	Learn to spell the Spring 2 High Frequency Words which were introduced this week: determined, dictionary, disastrous, equip, equipped, equipment, existence, explanation, foreign, frequently, variety.
Dictation	Ask an adult to read the following dictation for you to write down. It is based on the words that we are learning: Determined to improve the variety of his disastrous spellings, Bob equipped himself with a dictionary which he frequently used for the explanation of words.
Maths	Split your page into quarters. Label the sections with Addition, Subtraction, Division and Multiplication. In each section, make up 6 calculations appropriate to your level and solve them. You might consider using numbers with 2 decimal places in some of your calculations. For example, 18×7.2 ; 7437×23 ; $725 \div 29$; $79,884 + 6524$; $263.7 - 68.5$.
