This half term, we will be focusing on the following areas:

Maths: decimals, money, mass, volume and length.

English: fantasy/historical stories (Beowulf) and information texts and newspaper reports.

Science: animals, including humans.

History: the Viking Invasions.

DT: mouldable materials.

PE: swimming and rugby.

RE: prayer.

ICT: ipads.

MFL: Spanish, including cultural traditions and festivals.

A reminder that high frequency words will be issued this week to be tested next week. Please ensure your child can spell and use them correctly in their writing. We will also retest any HFW your child has not yet spelt correctly.

Swimming

We will be going swimming every Thursday afternoon. The children will need their swimming kit in school every Thursday. Please remember the following:
