Y4 Educational Visit

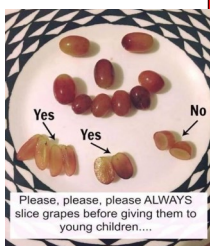

Please, please, please ALWAYS slice grapes before giving them to young children....

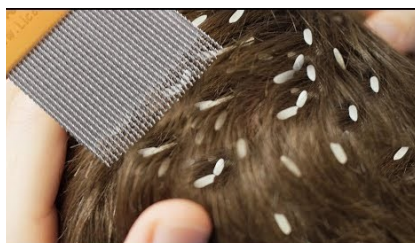
Weather
