# **Religious Education**

What do Christian's learn from the creation story?

We will look at the story of creation from Genesis 1-3 and consider what impact this has on the lives of Christian's around the world.

We will make links between God the Creator and His plans for His Earth. We will consider how Christian's can be caretakers of His Earth to continue God's work.

#### Science

Plants – How do plants transport water and food? How can you affect how a plant grows?

Children will plan and conduct tests to identify what plants need to survive.

#### Art

Collage: Work collaboratively and use a variety of images, textures and colours to make posters to represent the culture of the Ancient Greeks.

#### **English**

Verb forms – using present perfect forms of verbs.

Poetry writing using similes to describe the Christian Values.

Narrative writing – using descriptive phrases to add impact to stories.
