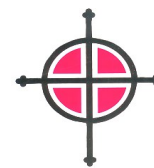

For example, did you know that dragonfly nymphs shoot out their pincer-like mouthparts to grab passing prey? We had some time down on the shore line and completed a scavenger hunt, collecting clues about some of the creatures which live there from what is left behind as well as observing live crabs in this habitat. The favourite activity for many of us was in the meadow with the nets, sweeping through the long grass - very hot but great fun! Altogether, we had a great day of outdoor learning.
