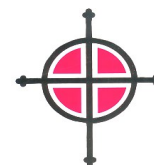

School Uniform—Polite Reminder

Please see the school website regarding our school uniform policy, you will also find the details of the two suppliers we use for our uniform. All sweatshirts, cardigans and jumpers must have the school logo on them, the children will also need a school book bag from the suppliers as it fits into the classroom trays and a drawstring PE bag, which fits on the pegs.

Advance Notice School Meals

From September, due to the size of the school increasing and a lack of capacity in the hall, KS2 (junior) children will only be able to stay for a hot dinner if they have one all week. You will only be able to opt in and opt out of this every half term.

Y2 children moving into Y3 must set up accounts if they want to purchase a school dinner for at least half a term or purchase toast at morning break.
