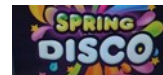
Spring Disco

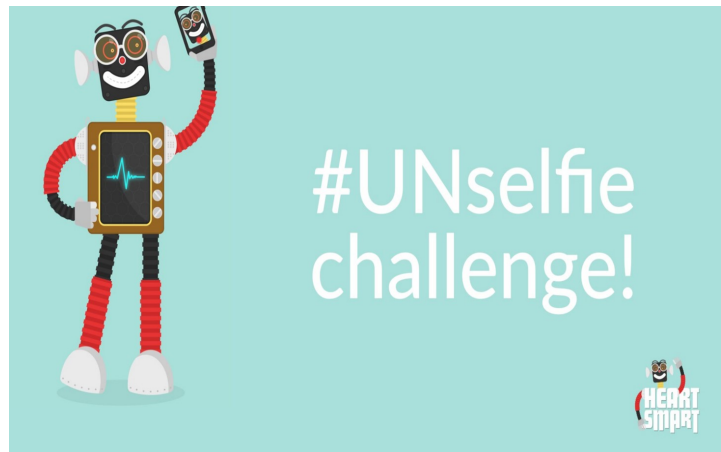


Unselfie Challenge Winners
