Here is a list of activities that you could do over the Easter break to keep you busy during our time off.

These activities are fun but completely optional!

Watch your favourite film.	Follow a recipe. Bake a cake or help to prepare a meal for your family. Make sure there is an adult who can help you.	Play a game with your family.	Facetime a relative or friend. Talk to them about what you have been learning at home.
