## Paper Plate Diva Lamp

#### Supplies

- A small paper plate
- Coloured paper or card
- Glitter
- Acrylic jewels or sequins
- PVA Glue
- Paint
- Paintbrush
- Scissors







First, paint one side of your paper plate.



Use glue to stick the candle down inside the folded plate.



When the plate is dry, fold it in half so that the paint and glitter can be seen on the outside. This should form the base of your diva lamp!



Then, cut a flame shape out of some yellow, orange or gold paper. A little glitter could be sprinkled on this too!



Next, cut a small semi-circle shape out of the middle of the folded part of the plate.



Stick the flame to the top of the candle and allow to dry.



Now, make a candle for your diva lamp! To do this cut a rectangle shape out of some card. This should fit into the hole in the middle of the folded plate.



Now decorate your paper plate diva lamp, perhaps by sticking some jewels or sequins on using PVA glue.



To finish add a little bit of glitter to create some sparkle and stand your finished diva lamp on a table or shelf to celebrate Diwali!



# Paper Plate Diva Lamp



### Supplies

- A small paper platePaintbrush
- Coloured paper or card
  - Scissors

- Glitter
- Acrylic jewels or sequins
- PVA Glue
- Paint





**Step 1.** First, paint one side of your paper plate.



Step 2. When the plate is dry, fold it in half so that the paint and glitter can be seen on the outside. This should form the base of your diva lamp!



**Step 3.** Next, cut a small semi-circle shape out of the middle of the folded part of the plate.



Step 4. Now, make a candle for your diva lamp!

To do this cut a rectangle shape out of some card. This should be the right size to fit into the hole in the middle of the folded plate.



**Step 5.** Use glue to stick the candle down inside the folded plate.



**Step 6.** Then, cut a flame shape out of some yellow, orange or gold paper. A little glitter could be sprinkled on this too!



**Step 7.** Stick the flame to the top of the candle and allow to dry.



**Step 8.** Now decorate your paper plate diva lamp, perhaps by sticking some jewels or sequins on using PVA glue.



Step 9. To finish add a little bit of glitter to create some sparkle and stand your finished diva lamp on a table or shelf to celebrate Diwali!
