Teddy is given one Christmas.



Eva is given two







I got more than you did because my number is bigger.

I got more than you did because I got two notes.



Who is correct?

Explain your reasoning.

Both Teddy and Eva are wrong because they both have £10.

Eva has two £5 notes, which makes £10, and Teddy has a £10 note.

Jack, Rosie and Amir each have some money in their pockets.

Jack and Amir both have coins and Rosie

has a note.

I have more money than Rosie.

Amir Amir

I have less money than Rosie.







Jack

What note could Rosie have?

Rosie could have a £5 note. She could not have a £10 or a £20 note because they are larger than Amir's amount.

Always, sometimes, never

Money in notes is worth more than money in coins.

Sometimes - if you have £6 in coins it is worth more than a £5 note.

However you could also have less than £5 in coins.
