**Religious Education**  
Called by God: The children will look at stories from the Old Testament, and analyse how and why individuals were called by God. They will consider what impact this calling had upon their lives. They will then use this to learn about famous figures from modern times. People who have served God or have used God's strength to help them to serve others.

**Personal, Social & Health Ed**  
Taking care of the environment: What are our responsibilities towards our environment? How can we be a positive part of a community?

**Computing**  
Using iPads to take photographs and film clips to edit into published movies.

**Physical Education**  
Swimming: Children will continue with targets from last half term and learn crucial survival skills.  
Rugby: Passing and receiving a ball. Attacking and defending to score points in a team game and prevent the opposition from scoring.

**Science**  
Light: What is darkness and how are shadows formed? Investigating how shadows change over time and how light can be reflected from a range of surfaces.

**Art**  
Facial expressions: Use Manga style to create faces and alter the eyes and mouths to create a range of facial expressions.

**English**  
Descriptive writing linked to the events that led up to the destruction of Pompeii.  
Non-fiction writing: What are volcanoes and how were they created? Are there different types of volcano?  
Poetry: extended list poems.

## Year 3 Summer 2 Project: What happened in Pompeii?

**Mathematics**  
Fractions: Finding a fraction of a group or number. Adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator. Finding equivalent fractions and ordering fractions with different denominators. Making one whole by adding fractions.

**Spanish**  
Going on a picnic! – Learn the names of common picnic foods. Say which foods that you like and which you dislike. Ask for particular foods.

**Geography**  
What is a volcano and an earthquake? How can we find them on a map of the world? Can we predict where they might be?

**Wow Experiences**  
Shadow puppet theatre – science  
Erupting volcanoes – Children will make volcanoes as part of DT and then use science skills to compare eruptions.

**Design and Technology**  
Research how to build 3D structures using a range of materials and then these to make the basic shape of a volcano and use mod-roc to define its shape and contours.

**Visit or Visitors**  
Greek Workshop: A drama workshop to demonstrate the differences between Athenians and Spartans.

**Cultural Appreciation**  
Does God just help Christians? How can Christians help people of all faiths?
