Harvest: How do Christian's celebrate harvest, and how do other faiths and cultures celebrate?

Christmas: Think about how God is always with us, and within us through Jesus.

Use the story of Papa Panov to think about how God changes our lives, and the lives of others.

Personal, Social & Health Ed Relationships: How to respond to others and how to deal with hurtful behaviour. The importance of self-respect, courtesy and being polite.

Physical Education
OAA: Children will learn
how to work as part of a
team to solve a problem.
For example: Using maps

school.

Multi-skills: Develop agility, balance and coordination through activities.

Science

Forces and Magnets: Children will learn what a force is and what it is that makes objects, move, accelerate, decelerate and stop.

They will plan a range of investigations throughout the term to observe how magnets act upon a range of materials and objects, and to decide which magnet is the strongest. They will consider how magnets are useful in the wider world.

English

Narrative: What makes a story? Children will develop their understanding of story to write plot points. They will develop their understanding of how to begin sentences and use varying sentence structures to improve the cohesion of their writing.
