## Reception - Elf Run



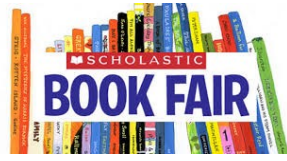
On Tuesday 15th December, Reception will be taking part in the annual St Rocco's Hospice Sponsored Elf Run.
