Describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system. Describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth. Be able to describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as spherical bodies and explain how we get day and night.

Collage/Mixed Media: studying the artist Beatriz Milhazes (abstract art) to develop our own observational drawing skills, use shapes and patterns and paint with complementary colours.

Diary writing using personal thoughts and feelings.

Story writing creating our own Mayan creation stories.

Mathematics

Multiplication using 2-digit numbers by 2-digit numbers & 3-digit numbers by 2-digit numbers. Division by 10, 100 & 100.

Preparation of a class Christmas message that will be sent home via video before Christmas.

Music

To use musical vocabulary to describe what can be heard and compare to other songs. To improvise within a group using melodic and rhythmic phrases. Look at the structure of rock songs and the instruments in the band with a main focus on composition in this style (Living on a Prayer – Bon Jovi)
