

### Covid-19 (coronavirus) - Change to the length of Isolation Periods

### Change to the length of Isolation Periods

A change to the self-isolation period from 14 to 10 days was announced on Friday 11th December for those who have contact with a positive case.

Communication from Public Health England colleagues states that the self-isolation period should be calculated as follows:

Isolation periods will take the day contact occurred as Day 0 of the isolation period

You must remain in isolation until Day 11

For example, contact on 18th December 2020 = Day 0; last day of self-isolation is 28th December 2020 = Day 10; able to resume normal activities on 29th December 2020 = Day 11
