

On Monday 4th January it was announced that from 00:01am on the 5th January we would begin a National Lockdown due to the rising Covid cases and the new Covid variant.

Isolation Periods

A reminder that the length of self-isolation periods changed from 14 to 10 days on Friday 11th December for those who have had contact with a positive case and that they should be calculated as follows:

Isolation periods will take the day contact occurred as Day 0 of the isolation period

You must remain in isolation until Day 11

For example, contact on 18th December 2020 = Day 0; last day of self-isolation is 28th December 2020 = Day 10; able to resume normal activities on 29th December 2020 = Day 11
