We can sort animals into 3 groups based on what they eat.

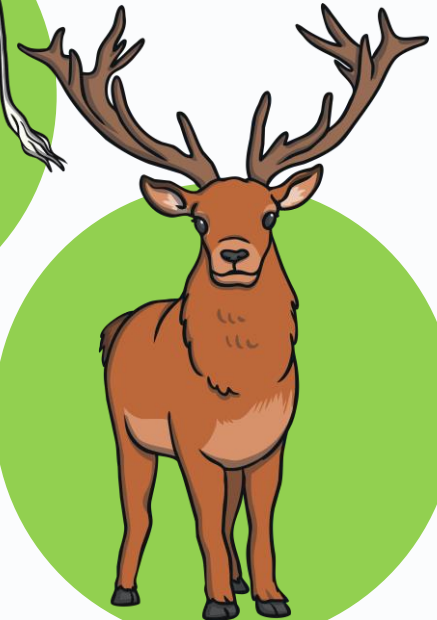
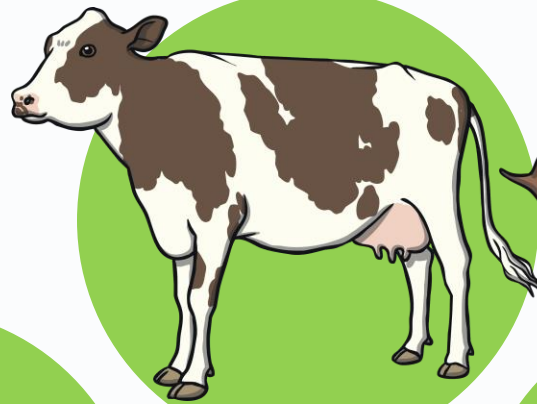
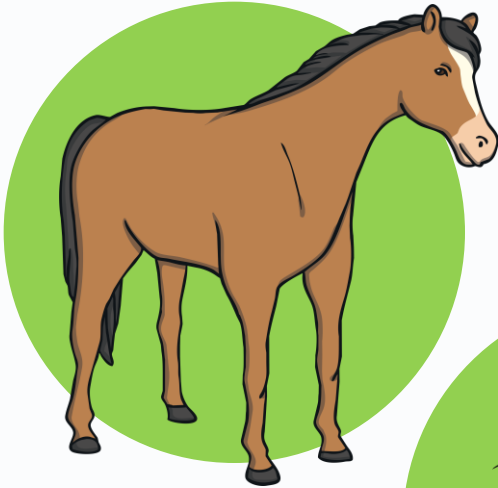
# Herbivores



Herbivores are animals that only eat plants.



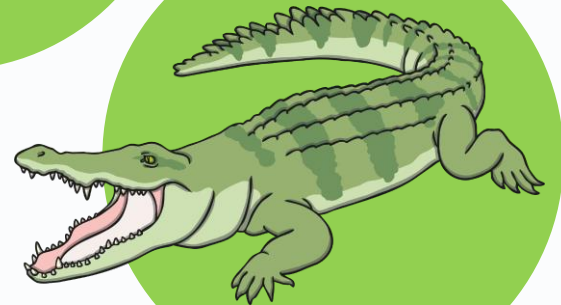
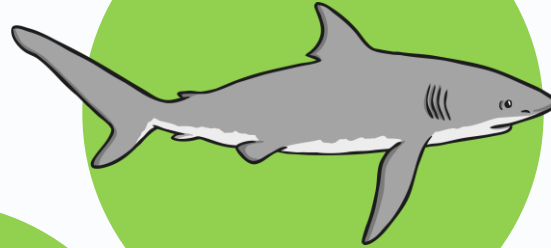
These can be flowers, fruit, nuts, grass or even wood.



# Carnivores

Carnivores are animals that only eat **meat**.

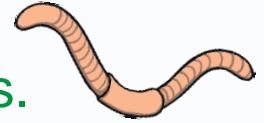
These animals have to catch animals to eat.



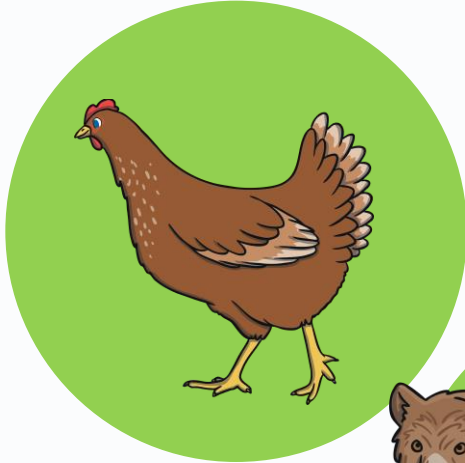


# Omnivores

Omnivores are animals that eat **meat** and **plants**.



These are animals like chickens that can eat seeds and worms.



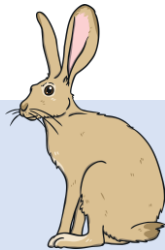
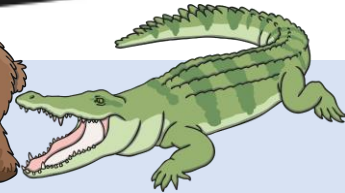
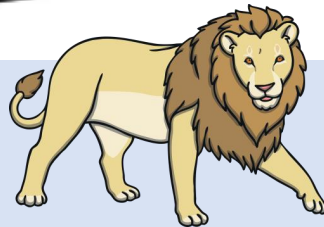
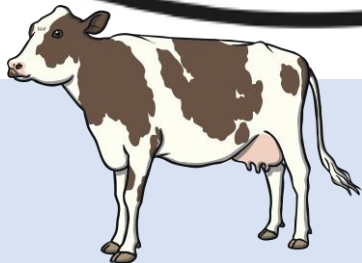

I eat beetles, worms, slugs, snails, fruit and berries.

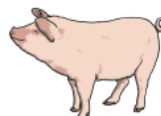
