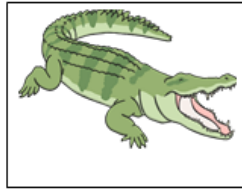
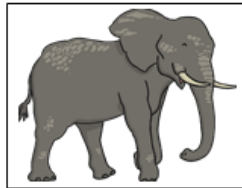
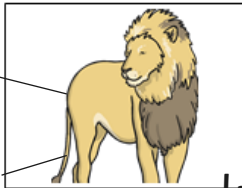
I can use alliteration
