## Religious Education

What is joy? What is sadness?  
We will reflect on Easter story and relate it to joy and sadness. Which describes Easter? How would you explain this?  
Children will learn to make links between people's behaviour and their beliefs and think about their own emotions linked to the Easter story. They will consider the impact that Easter has on cultures around the world.

## PSHE

Living in the Wider World:  
Children will learn how to handle money and about the concept of enterprise. We will look at jobs and skills and challenge stereotypes.

## Physical Education

Athletics: Children will challenge themselves to improve their personal best times and distances.  
Gymnastics: Children will develop their core strength to control movement, and jumps. They will learn to control tension to support their movements when performing.

## Science

Skeletons and Muscles: Children will learn about the functions of bones and muscles in animals and think about how they differ in a range of living things. They will learn about the differences between bones and joints, and think about how muscles work in pairs to make movement possible.  
The children will also conduct a series of pattern seeking tests to look for relationships. They will conduct tests to see if physical features have an impact on physical performance.

## Computing

We will develop our typing skills and learn to publish our writing using Google Docs, thinking about presentation.

## English

Non-fiction: This half term, the children will look at the features of instructions and non-chronological reports. They will learn how to use imperative verbs in their writing and the impact this has on the reader.  
They will also learn to write free verse to tell a story.

## Mathematics

Money: Making amounts using coins and notes.  
Finding change and solving word problems,  
Graphs: Recording information on bar graphs and pictograms. Answering questions about graphs.  
Angles: identify right angles, obtuse and acute angles. Describe the properties of shapes.

## Spanish

Spanish names of carnival and playground games.  
Easter celebrations: the names of days in the Easter Story. Names of colours.

## Geography

Europe: Children will identify countries in Europe, and discuss similarities and differences across the continent.

The children will think of their own questions and how they can investigate to find an answer.  
Cat Walk: Children will share their completed t-shirts in their own fashion show.

Children will look at how designers use mood boards to develop their ideas. They will create their own mood boards and design and make their own t-shirt.
