



<p>Religious Education Jesus, The Man Who Changed Lives. Children will look at passages from the New Testament, and consider how Jesus changed the lives of individuals at those times. We will learn about the impact that He has had on people of today, and how this has helped them to improve the lives of others around the world. We will think about how following Jesus' path can help us to be better people and make a better world.</p>	<p>Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education. Health and Wellbeing - Growing and changing.
