
Covid-19 (Coronavirus) - Contract tracing over half term.

Parents should only contact school if their child, who is a pupil at the school, exhibited COVID symptoms up to and including Saturday 3rd April and subsequently receives a positive test result. If they were asymptomatic but have had a test up to and including Saturday 3rd April and subsequently receive a positive test result, they should also inform school.

Parents / carers will need to leave a voicemail or text on the number 07949 852541 with the following information:

- Child's name / DOB / class / Post Code
- When symptoms started, or the date of the test if asymptomatic
- The test date
- When the child was last in school

This number will only be monitored between 12 noon – 2pm until Wednesday 7th April. All other positive cases of pupils in school will need to be reported via email to stphilips_primary@warrington.gov.uk
Children should not return to school until after 10 days isolation has been completed.

British Values Day

On Friday 23rd April all children are asked to attend school in their own clothes to celebrate British Values Day and to wear something red, white or blue.

This week, year 5 have been food tasting in preparation for baking bread in DT. The children have designed their own bread after completing a sensory evaluation (food tasting) as research to decide on the best ingredients to add to their recipe. We have had some very creative designs! The children have had a fabulous Spanish Carnival day today where they enjoyed tasting their bread which was accompanied with a Spanish style topping. The children have enjoyed evaluating the taste and appearance of their bread and have made decisions on how they could improve their design. The children then had a debate about the importance of learning a foreign language. They were all enthused by this topic and shared some sensational answers which peers then elaborated on during a really good debate.



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
