Religious Education

What do Christians learn from the creation story?

We will look at the story of creation from Genesis 1-3 and consider what impact this has on the lives of Christians around the world.

We will make links between God the Creator and His plans for His Earth. We will consider how Christians can be caretakers of His Earth to continue God's work.

Personal, Social & Health Ed

Rights and responsibilities:

Children will learn about issues that affect their health and wellbeing, and consider different cultures, customs and traditions of people living in the UK.

Computing

Programming : The children will develop their programming skills using 2Code, and learn key vocabulary.

Physical Education

Netball: The children will learn the key skills of netball. How to receive a ball and pass it on, and how to defend.

Athletics: We will develop the children's skills in a range of throwing and running disciplines. Children will record personal best and aim to improve their times and scores.

Science

The children will learn what light is and where it comes from. They will discover how light can be changed to create effects and how shadows are formed. They will then investigate how shadows change size and shape and why.

Art

Children will learn how to use a range of materials to make craft puppets, sock puppets, shadow puppets. They will use their puppets to retell a Greek myth.

English

Verb forms – using present perfect forms of verbs.
Poetry writing using similes to describe the Christian Values.

Narrative writing – using descriptive phrases to add impact to stories.

Year 3 Summer 1 Project: Can we make puppets to tell a story?

Mathematics

Graphs: Recording information on bar graphs and pictograms. Answering questions about graphs.
Lines: perpendicular and parallel lines, calculating the perimeter of shapes
Angles: identify right angles, obtuse and acute angles. Describe the properties of shapes.

Spanish

Food we eat everyday – learn the names of fruit and breakfast foods. Practise pronunciation and listening.

History

Research how the Ancient Greeks lived. How are their lives similar/different to other historical times?

Wow Experiences

Recording performances in music to share with other classes.

Music

Play glockenspiels and percussion instruments for a variety of song parts. Compose an introduction piece.

Visit or Visitors

Ancient Greece drama and art workshop.

Cultural Appreciation

Does the message from the creation story affect non-Christians?
