## Religious Education

**Called by God:** The children will look at stories from the Old Testament, and analyse how and why individuals were called by God. They will consider what impact this calling had upon their lives. They will then use this to learn about famous figures from modern times. People who have served God or have used God's strength to help them to serve others.

## Personal, Social & Health Ed

**Taking care of the environment:** What are our responsibilities towards our environment? How can we be a positive part of a community?

## Computing

We will develop our publishing skills using 'Clips'. The children will make presentations that include pictures.

## Physical Education

**Softball:** Children will develop their bowling techniques and striking of a ball using a bat.  
**Cross Country and Javelin:** Children will learn how to pace a longer distance run and the correct technique to throw a javelin.

## Science

**Rocks & Soils:** The children will learn how rocks and soils are made. They will compare differences and similarities in rocks and learn which are igneous rocks and which are metamorphic rocks and the events which form them. The children will conduct experiments to consider which soil drains best and learn how to raise their own questions and plan a fair test investigation.

## English

We will focus on vocabulary and using a thesaurus as well as using a range of sentence types for effect. Pompeii will be our stimulus. Non-fiction writing: Children will write reports by asking: What are volcanoes and how were they created? Are there different types of volcano?

# Year 3 Summer 2 Project: What happened in Pompeii?

## Mathematics

**Time:** The children will learn to read the time using an analogue clock of numbers and Roman numerals, telling the time to the nearest minute. They will solve word problems associated with time to work out how long journeys take and how long events last for.

## Spanish

**Going on a picnic!** – Learn the names of common picnic foods. Say which foods that you like and which you dislike. Ask for particular foods.

## Geography

What is a volcano and an earthquake? How can we find them on a map of the world? Can we predict where they might be?

## Wow Experiences

**Erupting volcanoes –** Children will make volcanoes in small groups as part of design and technology and then use science skills to compare eruptions across the groups.

## Design and Technology

The children will design and make their own soft toy based on the book, 'The Barnabus Project'. They will develop a range of joining techniques and evaluate their finished product.

## Visit or Visitors

The children will visit Foxhowl in Delamere Forest and take part in outdoor learning.
