form	The shape of an object, one of the seven elements used to create a piece of work.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can create a mood board that shows a selection of pictures, colours, photographs, words and drawings.
mood	The atmosphere in a piece of work and the feeling expressed.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can create samples of tie-dye fabrics for my mood boards/sketchbooks.
technique	A practical method or process used to create a piece of art.		
material	What something is made from.		
media	The type of material used by an artist to create the piece of work. e.g. charcoal, paint, pencil.	Mood Board	<input type="checkbox"/> I know why we need gloves, aprons and protective sheeting.
mood board	A collection of pictures, colours and textures to show their designs and inspiration.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can produce a fashion illustration, inspired by one of the artists.
tie-dye	A process used to make unusual patterns in fabric by tying the material in parts and covering it in dye.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know how to scrunch, fold or coil to create a tie-dyed piece of material and t-shirt.
textile designer	An artist who designs printed, knitted or woven textiles.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can cut material neatly into a chosen shape. <input type="checkbox"/> I can thread a needle. <input type="checkbox"/> I can sew the shape on to my t-shirt using a running stitch.
synthetic materials	Man-made materials.
