


Epistles	The letters written by the Apostles to different nations about Christianity.		
Apostles	What the disciples were called after they had received the Holy Spirit and started to spread Christianity.		
persecution	Treating someone badly because of their beliefs or who they are.		
missionary	A person who goes (usually) abroad to convert people to Christianity.		
Holy Spirit	The third part of the Trinity: God is active everywhere.
