


form	The shape of an object, one of the seven elements used to create a piece of work.		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> I know how to blend tones smoothly and gradually. <input type="checkbox"/> I know how to hold my pencil properly when shading. <input type="checkbox"/> I can shade from light to dark with accuracy and skill. <input type="checkbox"/> I can shade with skill following the four shading rules.
mood	The atmosphere in a piece of work and the feeling expressed.		
technique	A practical method or process used to create a piece of art.		
material	What something is made from.		
media	The type of material used by an artist to create the piece of work. e.g. charcoal, paint, pencil.	Shading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> I can cut and stick with precision. <input type="checkbox"/> I know how the shadow is created in a shadow puppet theatre. <input type="checkbox"/> I can make a workable puppet with clear features. <input type="checkbox"/> I can create a 3D model (puppet) of a mouse with its features in proportion.
tone	The lightness and darkness of a colour.	<p><u>Four Rules of Shading</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Shade in one direction. 2. Keep tones smooth – use your finger to blend the shading. 3. Make sure that there are no gaps. 4. Keep your edges neat. 	
craft	A skill in making things, especially with hands.		
puppet	A doll moved by your hands or strings.		
sketching	A fast, light drawing which is often used as a plan for drawing or painting.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> I can develop my drawing using colour, texture and detail. <input type="checkbox"/> I can mix paints to match the tone of grey needed. <input type="checkbox"/> I can paint neatly with control, ensuring good coverage. 	
shading	Using darker pencil marks to show the darker tones.
