

<b>seaside</b>	A place by the sea, especially a beach area or holiday resort.		
<b>Beach</b>	A beach is a landform found along the coast of an ocean, sea, or lake.		
<b>Sand dunes</b>	A hill or ridge of sand piled up by the wind is called a sand dune. Dunes may form wherever there is a lot of loose sand and enough wind to move it. <b>Irish sea</b>	The body of water that separates Ireland and Great Britain.		
<b>English Channel</b>	An arm of the Atlantic Ocean that separates Southern England from northern France		
<b>North Sea</b>	The North Sea is a sea that is part of the Atlantic Ocean in northern Europe.
