☐ There are two words for "a" in Spanish. These words are "un" (masculine) and "una" (feminine).

☐ Nouns add an "s" in the spelling sometimes in the plural in Spanish.

☐ In Spain, on 6th January, Spanish children receive Christmas presents from the 3 Kings on camels.
