



<b>fundamental movements</b>	Basic movements of hockey.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can use the right amount of power to send a ball to a partner.

<b>obstruction</b>	When a foot or another body part gets in the way of the ball.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can tackle the ball safely.
<b>rebound</b>	the ball bounces off another player's stick or the side of the goal		<input type="checkbox"/> I can pass a ball through a gate to a partner.
<b>intercept</b>	To take a moving ball that has been sent to someone.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can send and receive a ball accurately with a partner.
