



distortion	Amplified guitar sounds to create a gritty, growling or fuzzy sound.		<input type="checkbox"/> Heavily-amplified guitar
guitar pedal	This can be used to alter the level of distortion.		<input type="checkbox"/> Bass guitar
middle 8	The 8 bar section in the middle of a song which usually has the improvised section.		<input type="checkbox"/> Drums
stave	The 5 lines we write music on.		<input type="checkbox"/> Keyboard sounds
clef	This tells us how we read the notes.		<input type="checkbox"/> Often male vocals with backing vocals from other band members
drum kit	The combination of drums and cymbals which is used in a rock band.	How we compose	<input type="checkbox"/> Frequent solo guitar
projection	The strength of speaking or singing clearly so the voice is heard.	  	<input type="checkbox"/> Sometimes distortion of the sound
phrase	The unit of musical notes (metre) which makes sense on its own – like a sentence or phrase in writing.		<input type="checkbox"/> A heavy backbeat
solo	To play by yourself.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can order sounds to suit the style I am matching.
rock tempo	The fast, upbeat tempo used in rock music.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know that I should breathe at the end of a phrase, which is usually a sentence.
			<input type="checkbox"/> I can play my own part in a small group and class ensemble. (using glocks) using basic notation.
			<input type="checkbox"/> I can use key musical vocab (the elements of music) to: describe what I can hear, compare to other songs I know, and evaluate if I like the song.
