



Year 5: Danish Longball

attack	To throw the ball at the opposite team.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know how to negotiate obstacles.
runs	The striker must run from the kick plate to the bowlers cone and back to score a run.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know the rules of Danish Longball.
obstruction	When a player on the fielding team gets in the way of the striker.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know an effective tactic.
side-line	The long edges of the pitch.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can compete against others using effective tactics.
