



Year 5: Kwik Cricket

Subject Specific Vocabulary		Important Information	Important knowledge
wicket keeper	The player in a cricket team who stands behind the wicket		<input type="checkbox"/> I can pass accurately whilst moving.
wickets	A set of three stumps with two bails, at which the ball is aimed.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can target a specific area.
short barrier	Using one or two hands to stop and pick up a rolling ball.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can hit the ball with the middle of the bat.
long barrier	Crouching down and using a foot, leg and hands to create a barrier to stop a rolling ball.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can decide where is best to aim shots.
batting stroke	Deflecting the bat-face towards the leg side at the last moment.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can use different areas of the bat.
overarm bowl	A delivery in which the bowler's hand is above shoulder height.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can ensure the ball only bounces once.
underarm bowl	A delivery in which the bowler's hand does not go above waist height.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can review and amend my technique where required.
no ball	If the ball bounces twice before reaching the batsmen or is above their chest height.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can remember key rules.
boundary	The perimeter of the playing field,		<input type="checkbox"/> I can use different batting strokes.
innings	A specific team's turn to bat.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can bowl overarm.
