<b>bowling over</b>	6 good bowls delivered to the batsman.		
<b>crease</b>	lines on the field that separate different areas of the field from each other.		
<b>boundary</b>	The perimeter of a playing field.		
<b>wide</b>	A bowl that doesn't reach the bowler as it goes to either side.		
<b>bowled out</b>	The ball hitting the cricket stumps from a bowling motion.
