


form	The shape of an object, one of the seven elements used to create a piece of work.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know how to blend tones smoothly and gradually.
mood	The atmosphere in a piece of work and the feeling expressed.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know how to hold my pencil properly when shading.
technique	A practical method or process used to create a piece of art.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can shade from light to dark with accuracy and skill.
material	What something is made from.		<input type="checkbox"/> I can shade with skill following the four shading rules.
media	The type of material used by an artist to create the piece of work. e.g. charcoal, paint, pencil.	Shading	
tone	The lightness and darkness of a colour.	<u>Four Rules of Shading</u>	
craft	A skill in making things, especially with hands.	1. Shade in one direction. 2. Keep tones smooth – use your finger to blend the shading.	
puppet	A doll moved by your hands or strings.	3. Make sure that there are no gaps.	
sketching	A fast, light drawing which is often used as a plan for drawing or painting.	4. Keep your edges neat.	
shading	Using darker pencil marks to show the darker tones.
