<b>download</b>	An act of moving or copying a file, program.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know how to upload an image, edit the image and add a voice recording over the image
<b>edit</b>	Edit makes alterations. You can edit videos by trimming their start or end, cropping them, adding filters, and more		<input type="checkbox"/> I know how using technology can be a distraction from other things, in both a positive and negative way.
<b>soundtrack</b>	Soundtrack is adding a song or music to the video.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know how to add and edit live titles; trim and delete clips
<b>poster</b>	Posters can be used for titles and other text-based frames on your video.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know how to add posters and a soundtrack to Clips
<b>live titles</b>	Animated titles you create with your voice, in a style you choose. As you speak, text appears on the video. You can include the sound of your voice along with the Live Title, or you can mute your voice.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know how to plan an appropriate Clips video based on the Anglo-Saxons.
<b>content</b>	Content is the text, pictures, video, or anything else in the page or file.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know how to create a Clips presentation age appropriate about the Anglo-Saxons
