<b>body</b>	The main content (text) on the page.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know how to design an automated machine to respond to sensor data
<b>automated machine</b>	Word without the need for human interaction, after being programmed to carry out a specific job.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know how weather forecasts are made
<b>climate</b>	The weather conditions you would normally expect in a location.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know how to use green screen technology in a video to present a weather forecast
<b>device</b>	Equipment created for a certain purpose or job.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know some of the methods used to encourage people to buy things online
<b>forecast</b>	To predict what might happen or occur as the result of something in the future (for example, weather forecast).		
<b>log data</b>	A record of information that has been collected by a person or a computer, while monitoring something.		
<b>sensor</b>	A tool or device that is designed to monitor, detect and respond to changes for a specific purpose, such as a smoke alarm, which will ring if smoke is detected in the air.		
<b>source</b>	Where something comes from, for example milk is a source of calcium.
