<b>transition</b>	A transition is a visual effect that happens when one video clip changes to another.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know how to evaluate and modify a iMovie presentation
<b>pre-recorded</b>	A pre-recorded video is video that has been recorded prior to creating the movie. The video is uploaded to the timeline.		<input type="checkbox"/> I know ways technology can affect health and well-being both positively (e.g. mindfulness apps) and negatively.
<b>timeline</b>	The timeline is where you edit your movie by adding, arranging and trimming your video clips.		
<b>enable</b>	Enabling a feature allows you to do it.
