

Important knowledge about Healthy Eating

- ❑ The plural word for "the" in Spanish is either "los" or "las". We use algunos and algunas to say "some" with plural nouns e.g algunos zapatos (some shoes).
 - ❑ When we say and write colours as adjectives after the noun in Spanish, the spelling changes to match the noun and whether it is singular or plural and masculine or feminine. e.g. el jersey **blanco**/ los jerseys **blancos** la falda **blanca**/ las faldas **blancas**
