The Friends of St. Philip's are excited to announce the Colour Run 2023 this summer! It is the biggest event of the year and open to all pupil age groups, parents and siblings!

Tickets for pupils, older siblings (11+) and adults wishing to race are priced at £10 each, which includes entry to the race, warm up introduction, the paint powders thrown at each station and a medal. We will also be hosting a toddler water race for younger siblings (excluding powder) tickets for toddlers wishing to join in the water race are £2. Spectators can enter the event for free.

We are hoping to be able to raise some vital funds for the school on the day too so will be having extra treats outside the infant playground, on the car park and by St. Philip's Church.

The colour run will take place on the school field, each year group will run separately to ensure everyone can run the course and enjoy the day as safely as possible. To book your places, simply complete the form below and return with full payment to school, please send in a sealed envelope marked 'colour run'. We do advise returning your booking form as early as possible as places are limited and will be allocated on a first come first served basis. We will stop accepting forms on Monday 03rd July 2023, or when all places have been allocated, whichever comes first.

To get the best out of the day, all racers are encouraged to wear a plain white t-shirt so the colour powder will show up better. Protective glasses will be provided. The colour powder is non-toxic/ non-hazardous, eco-friendly and non-flammable.
